The need in the Greenville Branch service area

- In the ten counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Greenville, **145,280** individuals live in food-insecure households.
- **42,570** are children.
- **10,764** seniors live at or below the poverty level.

Programs

- Food Recovery (Fresh Produce and Retail Donation)
- Kids Meals & More (Kids Cafe, Weekend Power Pack, Kids Summer Meals, School Pantry)
- Three Squares for CENC (Food & Nutrition Services Outreach)
- Community Health & Engagement

How you can help

- Donate money: For every \$1 donated, five meals or \$10 worth of food is provided.
- Donate time: Volunteer as an individual or with a group.
- Donate food: Hold a food drive.

Greenville fast facts

- In fiscal year 2016-2017, the Greenville Branch distributed **15.8 million** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **185** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to more than **13.4 million** meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated **21,530** hours

Efficiency

- 97% of every dollar goes to food and food programs.
