FAST FACTS 101

MISSION:

- The mission of the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina is: No One Goes Hungry in Central & Eastern North Carolina.

WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO IN GREENVILLE:

- The Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Greenville is a non-profit organization that serves 10 of the 34 counties in the total service area.
- The Greenville branch serves Carteret, Craven, Greene, Jones, Lenoir, Onslow, Pamlico, and Pitt. Edgecombe and Wilson counties are shared with our Raleigh Branch. Carteret, Craven, Jones, Onslow and Pamlico are shared with the New Bern Branch.
- The Greenville Branch is located at 1712 Union Street in Greenville.
- The Greenville distribution center is 17,500 square feet.
- In fiscal year 2015-2016, the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Greenville distributed 8,182,562 pounds of food and partner with a network of 95 agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, group homes).

THE NEED IN THE GREENVILLE BRANCH SERVICE AREA:

Food insecurity is the state of being unable to consistently access nutritious and adequate amounts of food necessary for an active and healthy life. The households we serve experience limited or uncertain access to food, at times unsure of where they will find their next meal.

Per Feeding America's Map the Meal Gap 2015 report:

- In the ten counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Greenville, 146,670 individuals live in food insecure households.
- 44,530 are children.
- Additionally, per the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, 10,663 seniors (65 and older) live at or below the poverty level.

VOLUNTEERS IN GREENVILLE:

- Volunteers at the Greenville Branch donated 26,656 of their time during fiscal year 2015-2016.
- This is equivalent to approximately 13 full-time employees.

TRUCKS:

- The Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Greenville operates three trucks.

EFFICIENCY:

- For every dollar donated, to the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina is able to distribute generally ten dollars (\$10) worth of food or provide five meals.
- For every dollar donated to the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina, 97 cents goes directly to food and food programs.

OTHER FOOD BANK OF CENTRAL & EASTERN NORTH CAROLINA BRANCHES

DURHAM

- The Durham distribution center is located at 2700 Angier Avenue and is 29,000 square feet.
- The Durham Branch serves Chatham, Durham, Granville, Orange, Person, and Vance counties.

NEW BERN

- The New Bern distribution center is located at 205 South Glenburnie Road.
- The New Bern distribution center is 6,200 square feet.
- The New Bern Branch serves Carteret, Craven, Jones, Onslow, and Pamlico counties.

RALEIGH (main)

- The Raleigh distribution center is located at 1924 Capital Boulevard and is the main warehouse and administrative offices.
- The Raleigh distribution center is 85,000 square feet.
- The Raleigh Branch serves Duplin, Franklin, Halifax, Harnett, Johnston, Nash, Sampson, Wake, Warren, and Wayne counties. Edgecombe, Wilson, and Lee are shared with other branches.

SANDHILLS

- The Sandhills distribution center is located at 195 Sandy Avenue in Southern Pines.
- The Sandhills distribution center is 12,500 square feet.
- The Sandhills Branch serves Moore, Richmond, and Scotland counties. Lee County is shared with our Raleigh Branch.

WILMINGTON

- The Wilmington distribution center is located at 1314 Marstellar Street in Wilmington.
- The Wilmington distribution center is 11,190 square feet.
- The Wilmington Branch serves Brunswick, Columbus, New Hanover, and Pender counties.
