1-day USAC licenses (for the C race ONLY) can be purchased at the registration desk for \$10.00

Minimum prizes for A and B or A/B race is \$18 for three places (\$10/5/3). There are also prizes awarded in the A, B, and A/B races. Per USCF changes for 2006, no prizes are to be awarded in races exclusively for Category 5. This means there will be NO prizes for the C races. All USCF rules apply, including use of approved helmets, jerseys with shoulders and NO Aerobars are allowed. Prizes will not exceed \$499.

Combining Fields: In the event of reduced rider turnout, the race director and officials MAY decide to combine races based on projected entrants WITHIN 10 minutes PRIOR to the start of the B race. In general, the decision is made as follows: if we have 20 or more B racers and are already getting A racers signing in, it's likely that we will run separate A and B races. If we don't have 20 B racers and/or just a few A racers, then it's likely we will combine Fields.

Late Arrivals: Regardless of the week, ALL A and B RIDERS should be prepared to race at 10:15 am! Any rider entering a race late, whether it be 1 lap or 10 laps, MAY BE allowed to race, at the discretion of the Chief Official, but WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR ANY PRIZES.

Directions:

I-40 East: Take Gorman Street exit. Turn left onto Gorman. Turn right at second light onto Avent Ferry Road. Pass Trailwood Drive (light) and turn right at next light onto Varsity Drive. Turn right onto Capability Drive, then left onto Research Drive. Parking will be on your right.

I-40 West: Take Lake Wheeler Road Exit; turn right onto Lake Wheeler. Turn left at first light onto Centennial Parkway; follow to end. Turn left on Avent Ferry Rd. Turn left at first light onto Varsity Drive. Turn right onto Capability Drive, then left onto Research Drive. Parking will be on your right: Use Google Maps.
