MISSION:

- The mission of the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina: No One Goes Hungry in Central & Eastern North Carolina.

WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO IN WILMINGTON:

- The Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Wilmington is a non-profit organization that serves four of the 34 counties in the total service area.
- The Wilmington Branch serves Brunswick, Columbus, New Hanover, and Pender counties.
- The Wilmington distribution center is located at 1314 Marstellar Street in Wilmington
- The Wilmington distribution center is 11,190 square feet.
- In fiscal year 2015-2016, the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Wilmington distributed 7,633,278 pounds of food and partner with a network of 101 agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, group homes).
- The Wilmington Branch has experienced a 16% growth in distribution during the last four years.

THE NEED IN THE WILMINGTON BRANCH SERVICE AREA:

Food insecurity is the state of being unable to consistently access nutritious and adequate amounts of food necessary for an active and healthy life. The households we serve experience limited or uncertain access to food, at times unsure of where they will find their next meal.

Per Feeding America's Map the Meal Gap 2015 report:

- In the four counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Wilmington, 72,720 individuals live in food insecure households.
- 21,780 are children.
- Additionally, per the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, 5,936 seniors (65 and older) live at or below the poverty level.

VOLUNTEERS IN WILMINGTON:

- Volunteers at the Wilmington Branch donated 16,244 hours of their time during fiscal year 2015-2016.
- This is equivalent to 8 full-time employees

TRUCKS

- The Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Wilmington operates one truck.

EFFICIENCY

- For every dollar donated, to the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina is able to distribute generally 10 dollars (\$10) worth of food or provide five meals.
- For every dollar donated to the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina, 97 cents goes directly to food and food.

OTHER FOOD BANK OF CENTRAL & EASTERN NORTH CAROLINA BRANCHES

DURHAM

- The Durham distribution center is located at 2700 Angier Avenue and is 29,000 square feet.
- The Durham Branch serves Chatham, Durham, Granville, Orange, Person, and Vance counties.

GREENVILLE

- The Greenville distribution center is located at 1712 Union Street and is 17,500 square feet.
- The Greenville Branch serves Carteret, Craven, Edgecombe, Greene, Jones, Lenoir, Onslow, Pamlico, Pitt, and Wilson counties.

NEW BERN

- The New Bern distribution center is located at 205 South Glenburnie Road.
- The New Bern distribution center is 6,200 square feet.
- The New Bern Branch serves Carteret, Craven, Jones, Onslow, and Pamlico counties.

RALEIGH (main)

- The Raleigh distribution center is located at 1924 Capital Boulevard and is the main distribution center and administrative offices.
- The Raleigh distribution center is 85,000 square feet.
- The Raleigh Branch serves Duplin, Franklin, Halifax, Harnett, Johnston, Nash, Sampson, Wake, Warren, and Wayne counties. Edgecombe, Wilson, and Lee are shared with other branches.

SANDHILLS

- The Sandhills distribution center is located at 195 Sandy Avenue in Southern Pines.
- The Sandhills distribution center is 12,500 square feet.
- The Sandhills Branch serves Lee, Moore, Richmond, and Scotland counties.
